Sire: 425 WP 06 (3332/99 x 227/00)

Dam: 946 WP 07 3rd Final Race Noupoort One Loft (Beaten by 2mins)

The sire to this hen is the main inbred stock cock off brother Ref A x sister Ref A, he was Lot 68 on the Selected Stock Sale 30/9/18 and was always crossed out to the imported bloodlines for racing purposes. The dam was bred off the original Waldow pair, her sire was "Sylt Sanzibar" 56TH MDPR ex Deon Mathee 699/04 and her dam was the prolific hen 328/06 both bred by Werner Waldow. 946/07 achieved 3rd Noupoort Final and was purchased back for stock. 3737/17 achieved 15TH SWPC Britztown 15Bird 6th North Fed 3rd Club. She is also the same way bred as Frank Meyer (Ringo Star Lofts) super sisters 4404/12 and 4405/12. This hen is the last off this top-class pair. 3737/17 is the same as **LOT 53**

HEN: Blue Check WPHU 946/2007. Inbred Waldow – scored 4th final Noupoort.

This pigeon is the nestmate to 4404 and was a double union winner in the NRHU. The one win was also a WCPTA truck win as well as a Combine win with the FBHU (12 000 birds). The parents of the above nest pair are apparently available on this auction.

BB Cock 4407 - 35th NRHU Union Beaufort West 75th WCPTA (5531 birds)

LC Hen 4402 - 13th NRHU Union Hanover 20th WCPTA (5559 birds)

LC Hen 4402 - 29th NRHU Union Beaufort West 50th WCPTA (3863 birds)

Personally, the birds that I purchased from Saville have been exceptional in terms of both racing performances and more recently, breeding. (4405 bred my Laingsburg Union winner earlier this year)

Those of you who know Saville are aware of his participation and success at the one loft races, more specifically the MDPR. Saville has also spent a fortune on acquiring these superior stock birds.

This is a genuine opportunity for any fancier to obtain some of the best stock pigeons available in the Western Cape today.

Having looked back at the statistics for the SWPC for the period 2010 – 2018, Saville Penkin and Reuben Liddell have the most Combine wins in the strong SWPC, having each won 16 Combine races (statistics up to and including the Beaufort West of 8th September). This is testimony to the quality of pigeons that will be on offer.
